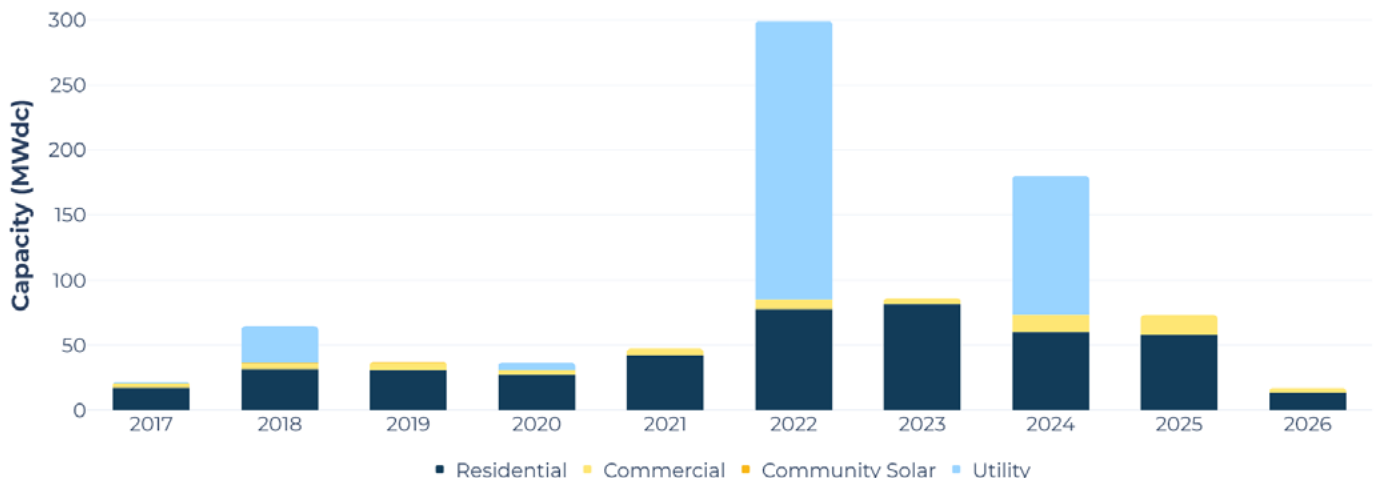

Olympia Fire Department Adds Solar to Save Thousands



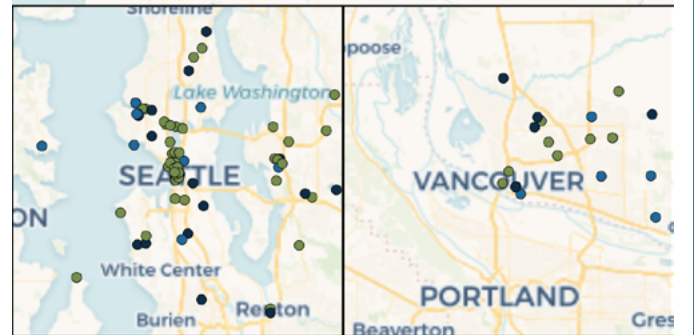
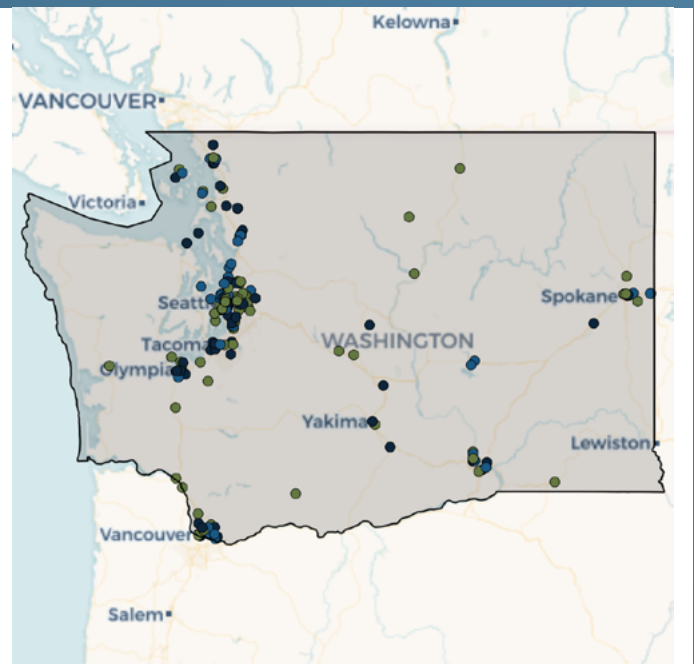
