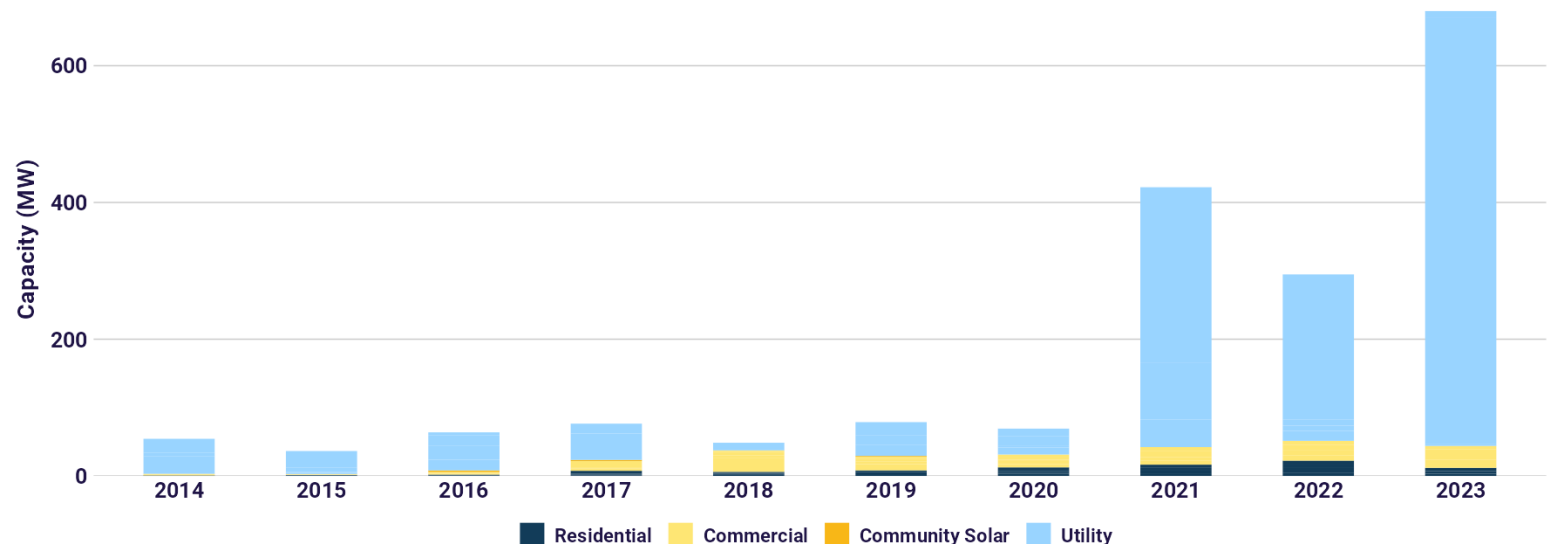

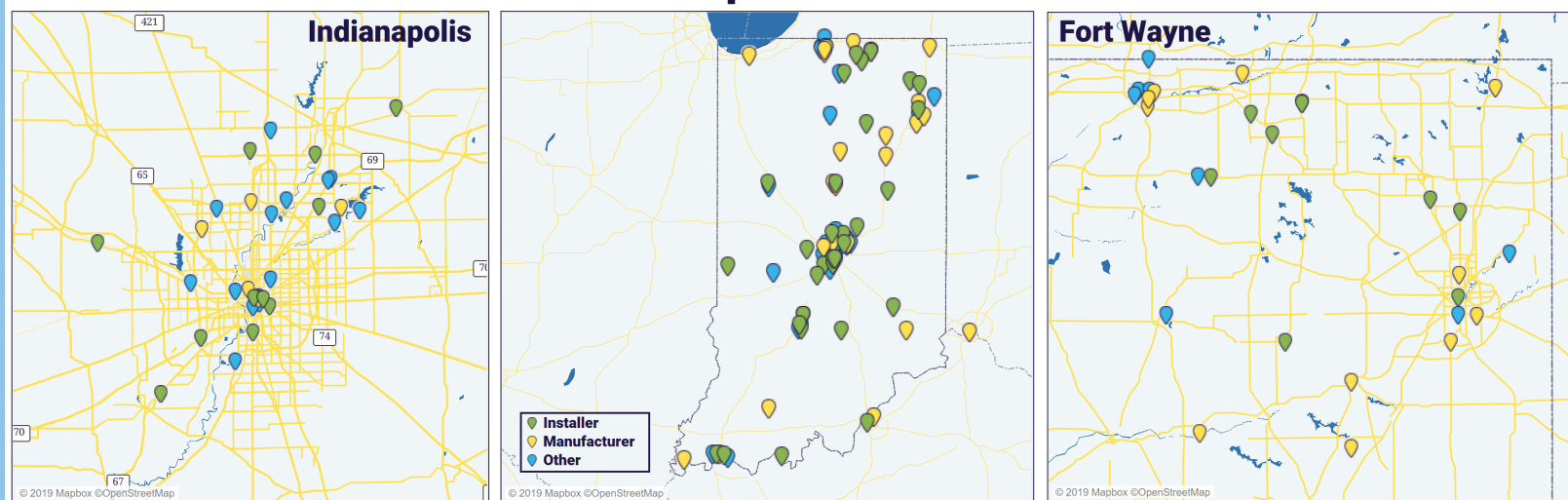

More information about solar energy Indiana

- Riverstart Solar Park in Modoc was developed by EDP Renewables and came online in 2021. This 255 MW project produces enough electricity to power 29954 homes.
- Prologis, Bendix, and Brookfield Properties Retail have all gone solar in Indiana. Prologis' 4 MW project in Indianapolis is one of the largest corporate projects in the state.
- At 65 MW, Troy Solar in Troy is among the largest solar installations in Indiana. Completed by CenterPoint Energy in 2021, this solar project has enough electric capacity to power more than 7635 homes.
