- Kawailoa Solar in Haleiwa was developed by Clearway Energy Group and came online in 2019. This 62.7 MW project produces enough electricity to power 16808 homes.
- Brookfield Properties Retail, Target, and Home Depot have all gone solar in Hawaii.
 Brookfield Properties 1.5 MW Retail's Ala Moana Center project is one of the largest corporate projects in the state.
- At 40.3 MW, Waianae Solar Project in Waianee is among the largest solar installations in Hawaii. Completed by Eurus Energy Corp in 2017, this solar project has enough electric capacity to power more than 10803 homes.
