

119th Congress

Republican Trifecta


- Republicans kicked off the 119th Congress with a five-seat majority in the U.S. House of Representatives the smallest margin of control in modern history.
- Three Republican seats are expected to be vacant until special elections are held later this Spring.
- Republicans hold 53 of 100 seats, with a potential tiebreaking vote from incoming Vice President JD Vance.

Reconciliation

• Reconciliation is a parliamentary technique that allows legislation to pass with a simple majority in the US Senate (normally 60 votes are required to proceed with legislation).

Reconciliation Instructions

- IRA credits are the largest pot of money outside of entitlements
- Every piece of the tax code is on the table, including energy credits.
- House approach currently includes addressing entitlements (Medicaid) to find pay-fors
- Ways and Means has \$4.5 trillion net available to pass tax cuts and Member priorities under the House-passed resolution.
- Senate and House currently working on final Budget reconciliation instructions.

House Budget menu eyes cuts to climate law credits, funding

A new document obtained by POLITICO lists a menu of items that Republicans are considering for cost-saving offsets for their planned package of tax cuts and other priorities.

House Republican lawmakers are targeting across-the-board cuts to climate change measures in Democrats' Inflation Reduction Act, including gutting the clean energy tax credits and grant programs under the law.

The document, prepared by House Budget Committee Republicans, includes repealing all of the clean energy tax credits "created and expanded under the Inflation Reduction Act," which it forecast would yield up to \$796 billion in savings over 10 years.

It comes as the Trump White House plows ahead on its efforts to roll back the Biden administration's climate agenda.





- Solar and energy storage are vital elements of American-made energy dominance.




Solar and Storage **Dominate** Pipeline for New Generation

Average U.S. Power Plant Development Timeline






States With the **Biggest** Solar Gains in 2024


Trump 2024 States

Harris 2024 States






American Solar Manufacturing is SOARING
