

Shaw Air Force Base Turns to Solar for Resilient and Reliable Electricity





James Island Fire Station Installs Solar at New Fire House




The James Island Fire Department added rooftop solar panels that will offset the energy the fire station uses during the day. This will allow the fire station to have safe, reliable power during emergency situations.
